Becoming a Climate Champion

Course Goals and Outline

The Becoming a Climate Champion e-course comprises five modules and a final assessment. After completing the e-course, participants should be able to:

- Devise an inclusive climate action project or initiative that contributes to the global efforts to tackle climate change.
- Outline a brief communications plan to promote climate-friendly projects and initiatives.
- Identify the resources needed to successfully implement a climate project or initiative.
- Describe key elements to consider when conceptualizing and implementing inclusive and gender-responsive climate projects and initiatives.
- Make use of different leadership styles in climate action projects and initiatives.

The estimated learning time is 3h to 3:30h in total.

Completion Requirements

The Certificate is awarded to participants who go through all the lessons and pass the final assessment scoring 70% or higher within three attempts.
